

2020 Marilyn Ott Memorial Scholarship

ONE \$500 SCHOLARSHIP AWARD AVAILABLE!

DEADLINE OF MARCH 1, 2020

SCCoLPA will be awarding one \$500 scholarship to a deserving high school senior, college student, or career change student. The scholarship will be awarded at SCCoLPA's monthly meeting in April 2020. The SCCoLPA scholarship winner is then entered into the contest for LSI's \$2,000/\$1,000 scholarships, which are presented in the memory of founder Eula Mae Jett.

CRITERIA: Scholarships awarded are for applicants enrolled in college or school in the fall of 2020 and spring of 2021 and the eligibility requirements are as follows:

Category A – High School Senior (high school seniors who have successfully completed high school by the end of June and will be enrolled in the fall semester immediately following the school year in a college or business school offering a course of study in the legal field. (LSI awards two scholarships, \$2,000 to the first place recipient and \$1,000 to the second place recipient in this category.)

Category B – College Student (students who have completed at least one year of college by June of the school year, and who will be enrolled in the fall semester immediately following the school year in a college or business school in a course of study in the legal field, until all such courses have been taken to satisfy the requirements for a degree or certificate in said legal related program. (LSI awards two scholarships, \$2,000 to the first place recipient and \$1,000 to the second place recipient in this category.)

Category C – Career Change Student (students who will be enrolled in the fall semester in a college or business school in a course of study in the legal field and shall be an individual who either (a) desires to re-enter the workforce but requires training or specialized education in order to qualify as a candidate for a position in the legal field; or (b) is currently working but desires to enter the legal field and wants to receive the training or specialized education needed to do so. (LSI awards two scholarships, \$2,000 to the first place recipient and \$1,000 to the second place recipient in this category.)

All scholarships under each category are applicable to California residents only.

APPLY: See attached scholarship application. Applicants must provide a biographical letter, three letters of recommendation, a school transcript, and a resume, if applicable. See attached checklist for further information.
