

What Are "Civil Rights"?

At its very inception - in the Declaration of Independence - the United States of America declared that "all men are created equal, that they are endowed by their Creator with certain unalienable rights, that among these are life, liberty, and the pursuit of happiness." These personal nonpolitical liberties, later specified and guaranteed by the Constitution against violation, have come to be called "civil rights." Though nonnegotiable, civil rights have not always been respected (e.g., slavery, poll taxes). Violations of civil rights have required precedent-setting legal decisions and government legislation to redress. The Civil Rights Act of 1964, for example, outlawed segregation in public facilities and racial discrimination in employment and education. Violations of a person's civil rights can be considered a federal offense and, depending on the severity of the violation, can be covered by civil or criminal law.

CCLS Monthly Quiz
