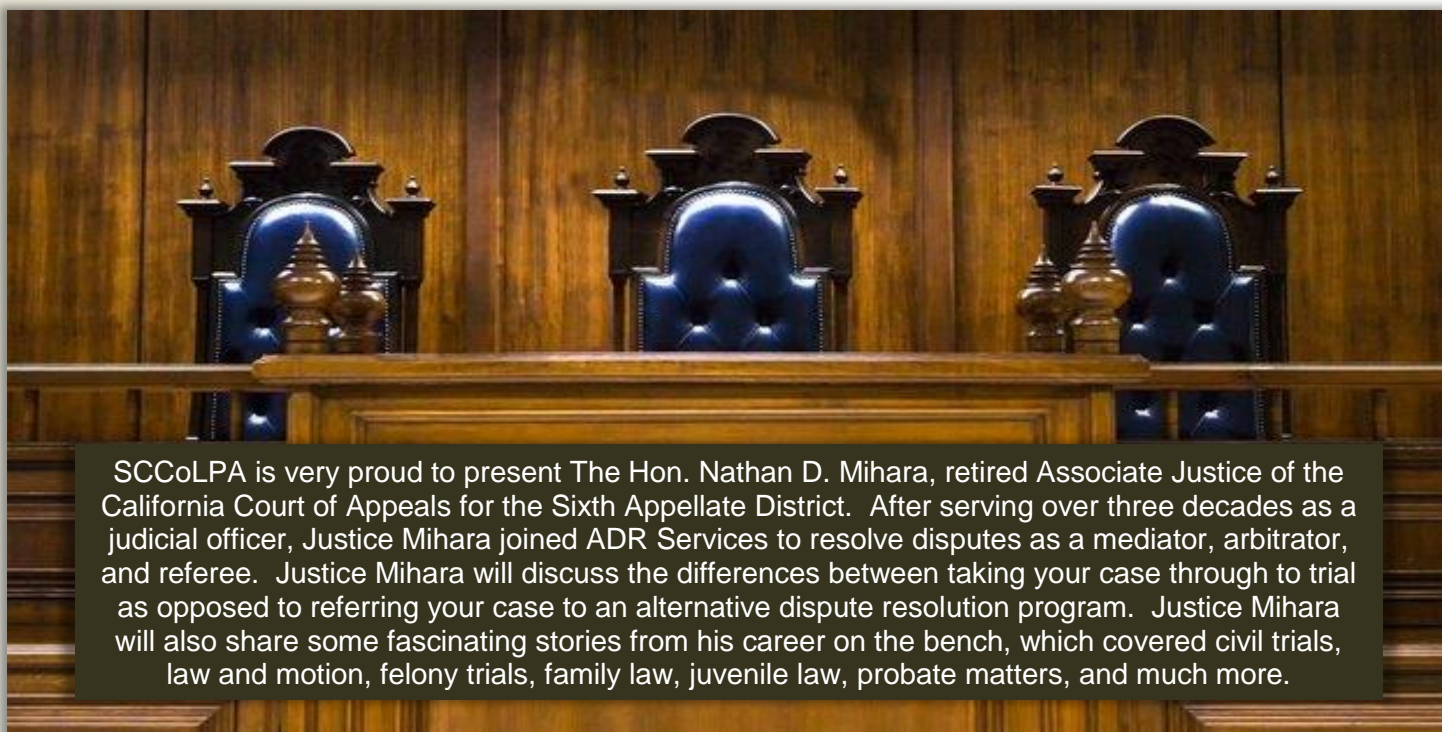


“Arbitration v. Trial: What’s the Difference and What’s the Best Way to Litigate Your Case?”
