There are multiple systems or approaches to using technology to perform document reviews. Generally, TAR is faster and accurate, if not more, and more cost-effective than human-only review. Our speaker will help you understand the basics and evolution of technology-assisted review, cover statistics highlighting its effectiveness, and explore AI's wider role in litigation beyond TAR.
